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School Consent Form for Students Participating in a Low Risk Activity

Dear Parent /Guardian(s):

Over the course of the school year we arrange field trips to engage students in their learning and community. These trips allow for students to discover learning and career opportunities outside the walls of the classroom; motivating students to bring and expand on learning in all aspects of their lives. Low risk activities include taking trips and attending events such as hikes, trips to a park, library or recreation center, a museum, movie or performing arts theatre or cultural/ career events and post-secondary institutions.

Students would simply need to wear appropriate clothing and conduct themselves in a manner consistent with WestShore Centre's Code of Conduct and School District #62 School Board Policies to participate. Student supervision will be covered by 2 school district employees at all times. In addition, support staff and administration will often accompany students outside the building as well. As high school aged students, there will be times during an outing when your child will not necessarily be supervised by an adult at all times. Clear expectations and directions in regards to student safety and supervision will be communicated to our students before, during and after all activities.

Transportation on trips will vary depending on our needs and budget. Transportation on trips will be provided by district school bus, public transport, or private vehicles registered with the school district (not students- only staff or parents) or on foot.

Accidents can be the result of the nature of the activity and can occur with or without any fault on either the part of the student or the School Board or its employees or agents, or the facility where the activity is taking place. By allowing you son/daughter to participate in these activities, you are accepting the risk of an accident occurring and agree that these activities as described above are suitable for your child.

If you do not wish your child to accompany his or her class on these trips, please contact the school at (250) 474 - 2505 to arrange for alternate supervision.
